ELEGANT, CRISP, ZESTY

Rayun Sauvignon Blanc (Valle Central, Chile) 23.50

Packed with pineapple and citrus fruits, strikingly vibrant throughout.

Pinot Grigio I Gadi (Veneto, Italy) 26.50

Surprisingly full and aromatic with bags of stone fruit character.

Waitonga Falls Sauvignon Blanc (Ohau, New Zealand) 26.50

Soft gooseberry, grass, nettles and a crisp light finish to captivate the palate.

Castelo de Medina Verdejo (Rueda, Spain) 28.00

Awarded 'Best white wine in Spain' it has classy aromas of grass, fennel, anise with ample flavours of citrus and apple. The finish is beautiful and persistent.

Muscadet 'La Divatte' (Loire, France) 30.00

Aged on lees for 8 months to give more roundness and a floral bouquet with overtones of spice and citrus.

Macon Villages 'Clos de Condemine' (Burgundy, France) 32.00

Light, fruity and classy with a rich vanilla undertone.

Chablis 'La Pierelee' (Burgundy, France) 45.00

Classic minerality. Refreshing and mouthwatering.

FRAGRANT, AROMATIC, ENTICING

Picpoul de Pinet 'Domaine de la Serre' (Languedoc, France) 27.00

A captivating fruity nose of peach and lemon with a clean finish.

Gavi (Piedmont, Italy) 32.00

A fresh fruity palate and its complex finish is reminiscent of almonds.

Sauvignon Blanc 'Supper Club' (Marlborough, New Zealand) 38.00

Supper Club Sauvignon Blanc is a true expression of Marlborough, characterised by intense tropical and passionfruit aromatics in combination with more delicate citrus and floral notes.

Sancerre 'Domaine des Trois Noyers' (Loire, France) 45.00

Upfront aromatic nose of nettles and blackcurrant leaves, the palate is full with crisp citrus acidity and a long balanced finish.

Gewurztraminer Grand Cru 'Kessler' (Alsace, France) 85.00

Mellow and fruity with enticing aromas of pear, chamomile and coriander. The wine is generous with fresh peach and pineapple notes in a creamy mouth feel.

RICH, RIPE, LUXURIOUS

Moscatel-Chardonnay 'Goru' (Jumilla, Spain) 28.00

Opulent, luscious white wine with ripe stone fruits, honey and flower aromas.

Villiera 'Jasmine' Fragrant White (Stellenbosh, South Africa) 38.00

An aromatic blend of Muscat, Riesling and Gewürztraminer with soft floral white petal bouquet balanced with a fresh and fruity finish.

Pouilly Fuisse 'Luquet' (Burgundy, France) 46.00

Generous and rich with a hint of hazelnuts, toasted almonds and exotic fruit. No oak influence, setting it apart from our other Burgundies.

Meursault 'Les Haut Bois' F. Martenot (Burgundy, France) 70.00

Aged in oak barrels for 9 to 12 months before bottling. With a golden colour, the nose combines vanilla, butter and hazelnut aromas; in the mouth, the wine is both firm, mellow and delicate.

Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru 'Les Embazes (Burgundy, France) 95.00

Graceful touches of oak, with dried nuts and honey adding complexity and lending their weight through the rich, ripe, yet flinty finish.

Bâtard-Montrachet Grand Cru '13 (Burgundy, France) 360.00

Beautiful, well-ripened aromas of orchard fruits. The palate is intensely fruity, with succulent layers of flavours and a soft touch of wood. Impressive length.

SOFT, SMOOTH, FRUITY

Barbera 'Cornale' (Piedmont, Italy) 22.00

A fine example of this famous regional grape, with forward cherry aromas and a warm velvety taste - everything a well structured, easy drinking red wine needs.

Tinto Joven 'Tondeluna' (Rioja, Spain) 24.50

Classic young Rioja made with 100% Tempranillo and no oak ageing.

An expressive character full of ripe red fruits and liquorice.

Montepulciano d'Abuzzo 'Ca Brigiano' (Marche, Italy) 27.00

Hand harvested with fermentation in steel tanks and no oak. It has generous fruit, medium bodied with a deep red colour and a softness that creates a very appealing style.

Pinot Noir {Noble Vines} 'Lot 667' (California, USA) 45.00

Cool fermented and with a little light barrel-ageing in a mix of French and American oak. It shows wonderful aromas of black cherry, earth and a touch of vanilla.

SOPHISTICATED, SILKY, JUICY

Tramuz (Ribera del Duero, Spain) 27.00

Complex nutty nose and palate dominated by fruit aromas of cherry and cinnamon, its softness and approachability enhanced by three months in French oak.

Hecht & Bannier 'Languedoc Rouge' (Languedoc, France) 32.00

A classic blend of Syrah, Grenache and Carignan packed with South of France fruit and spices. Organic.

Ronan de Clinet 'Merlot' (Bordeaux, France) 60.00

Ronan by Clinet is made by the winemaking team at Pomerol's celebrated Ch. Clinet. It is 100% Merlot - aromatic with hints of cherry, raspberry and blackcurrant, enlivened with sweet pepper.

Château Cantemerle '85 (Bordeaux, France) 125.00

Clear light red colour with intense leathery aromas on the nose and softer flavours of tobacco, leather, but red fruits beneath. Light bodied and elegant on the palate with gentle red fruited flavours mingled with more leather, graphite, tobacco and earth over fine grained tannins and good acidity.

DEEP, INTENSE, POWERFUL

Malbec Incienso 25.00

Soft and forward, nicely balanced between sweet fruit and dry tannins. Black fruits, spice and mocha entice the nose and palate which is rounded off with creamy vanilla oak.

Rioja Crianza 'Vallemayor' (Rioja, Spain) 30.00

Rioja Crianza spends a minimum of 12 months in oak barrels where it develops complex flavours of red and dark berries with toasty notes from a year oak ageing in a rounded, fruity and tannic style.

Clos la Coutale Cahors (Cahors, France) 42.00

The original Malbec, before it was made famous by Argentina. It was made soft & powerful, earthy, rich and deeply satisfying.

Prieto Picudo 'Cumal' (Castilla y Leon, Spain) 55.00

Incredibly complex wine from century-old vines. The nose is pungent and earthy. On the palate, exceptional ripe fruit and spices notes are balanced by a fresh, toasted finish.

Amarone della Valpolicella 'Cerasum' (Verona, Italy) 85.00

Made from grapes laid out in the sun for three to four months to concentrate its sugar and flavour; aged in oak this gives a remarkable warm bouquet reminiscent of dried fruits and spices.

Talbot '05 (Saint Julien, Bordeaux, France) 200.00

Licorice, cassis, blackberry with smoke and spices in a soft, approachable style.
The finish is round and fresh.

Armailhac '89 (Pauillac, Bordeaux, France) 250.00

The notes of tobacco, herbs and mint contrast with a savoury, earthy and leathery background. Medium body with a dry finish.

Dauzac '82 (Margaux, Bordeaux, France) 310.00

Good complexity of classic Bordeaux flavours with blackfruits over earthy, leafy notes. Silky and savoury in the mounth with a peppery finish.

L'Evangile '01 (Pomerol, Bordeaux, France) 360.00

Fantastic year now reaching its full potential. Opulent meaty texture with lush notes of black fruit over earthy flavours of liquorice and truffles.

Palmer '75 (Margaux, Bordeaux, France) 580.00

One of the top vintage: full-bodied, tannic structure rounded down by 50 years in the cellar. Plum, cherry and and spices at their best.

Mouton Rothschild '99 (Pauillac, Bordeaux, France) 850.00

Powerful and exceptionally concentrated wine offering notes of roasted espresso, creme de cassis, smoke, new saddle leather, graphite, and licorice.

Cheval Blanc '00 (St. Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux) 1100.00

It is a legend in the making and can actually be drunk now, as the tannins have nearly melted away. This is a beauty with incredibly complex aromatics.

Hecht & Bannier Provence Rosé (Provence, France) 33.00

Classic Provencal Rosé - pale salmon colour but with expressive floral notes backed by fennel or anise and offers immense charm and minerality on the finish.

Light yellow colour, floral hints, delicately fruity with apple, pear and citrus notes in a tasty, lively palate.

Tribaut Brut NV (Romery, France)	45.00
Family house champagne with light and crispy aromas of apple, brioche and a hint of apricot.	
Tribaut Brut Rosé (Romery, France)	50.00
Superb pink salmon colour with enticing red fruit aromas.	
Billecart Rosé (Mareuil sur Ay, France)	95.00
Delicate flavours of wild strawberry and cherry.	
Billecart-Salmon Blanc-de-Blanc (Mareuil sur Ay, France)	105.00
Fresh aromas of buttered brioche and mineral aromas.	
Vintage Bollinger (Ay, France)	130.00
Aromatic fullness with honey flavours, candied lemon notes and a delicious bitterness.	
Dom Perignon (Epernay, France)	195.00
Notes of wild flowers, ripe mangos and anise.	
Dom Perignon Rosé (Epernay, France)	400.00
Perfumed floral aroma, with hints of orange peel, dried fruits and woody spices.

Exceptional port-like wine showing unique flavours of cherry, strawberry and raspberry with notes of roasted coffee bean, cocoa and caramel.		
Châteaux De Fesles Bonnezeaux (Loire, France)	500ml	55.00
Concentrated and intensely aromatic, combining candied pineapple and caramelised pear flavours with rich toast and spice notes, cut through with Chenin's characteristic grapefruit-like acidity.
